Summary:

The Canada Games Coach will be responsible for planning, executing, and supervising all aspects of the Canada Games process. This will include, tryouts, training, pre-games competition, The Canada Games event, as well as all off court training, and events.

Reports to: NLVA Technical Director, and the CAD Committee Chair

Qualifications:

- Minimum Certified Advanced Development Coach (or equivalent)
 - Must be working towards Performance Coach
- Must complete a police records check
- Should possess standard first aid, with valid CPR training
- Have strong communication, organizational, and interpersonal skills
- Ability to work with spreadsheets, email, video programs, and other technology
- Experience with our provincial teams will be considered an asset
- Must be a registered member of the NLVA prior to application

Job Descriptions

General-

- Participate in the Development of a multi year seasonal plan by the head coach
- Participate in the Development of, and implementation of plans for all practices and matches
- Assist in the development and implementation of a quantifiable standard for team selection
- Make use of statistical analysis in tryout, practice, and match settings
- Assist in the planning and execution of all tryouts, practices, matches and off court events
- Ensure that a professional and respectful environment exists at all times.

Communication:

- Athletes and parent inquiries must be responded to in a timely fashion
- Attend CAD conference calls when necessary
- Attend the NLVA AGM

Administration

- The NLVA office will assist with any administrative tasks the assistant coach may require, including the items below
- The NLVA will provide an account for team funds, as well as a visa for any purchases that are required.
- The assistant coach is required to plan any team travel, exhibition matches or tournaments (this does not include the Canada Games)
- Administer the selection and ordering of apparel, jerseys, and other team gear

Coaching

- The Assistant Coach will be responsible for all assisting the head coach, with all coaching duties
- The assistant coach will be required to provide a written evaluation of program as a whole each year.
- Assist the head coach with any mentor coaching
- Maintain a professional relationship with all athletes, coaches, parents, NLVA staff, committee members

Other Duties

As the Canada Games is the highest level of programming the NLVA has to offer, we like to highlight the coaches and athletes in the program to our membership as often as possible. The main avenue for this introduction is our Provincial Team Program. Canada Games coaches are expected to participate in the Team NL tryout process as lead coaches. They are also expected to contribute to the selection of athletes for the summer programs.

Professional Development

Coaches are encouraged to pursue professional development opportunities. The NLVA will strive to provide these opportunities when possible, however coaches can, and should request any opportunities that they feel are appropriate.

- Sample practice plans (Method 1- Method and simulated play included), from various point in the season
- A coaching resume
